Comment:

1. Safety of the villages – importance of footpaths between Trefonen and Treflach and Nantmawr. Also speed safety activity.
2. Preservation of assets – both public houses to remain. Barley Mow and Royal Oak to remain as public houses and brewery to remain. Historic walls to remain as part of culture and history of village
3. Health – to consider benefits of health and exercise and need for social contact, to provide opportunities to encourage walk groups, cycle groups, social groups
4. Network – to support and encourage local travel e.g. bus route to be available and possible pick up drop off service to local town
5. Housing – need to provide real affordable housing but to prevent any blurring of the three villages that should remain independent but co-productive with one another.
